



HOW TO FILL OUT THE SON OF THE YEAR AWARD

- GENERAL:** Squadrons should submit their nominee, if any, to the Detachment Adjutant, who will forward them to the Chairman of the Son of the Year Committee. The person nominated should have earned outstanding merit in respect to their community, state, or nation and/or to the Sons of The American Legion and/or The American Legion Family.
- PERIOD:** The period of this volunteer's award should be from Detachment Convention to subsequent Detachment Convention. Overlapping periods will not be counted.
- ACTIVITIES:** This section should be completed in detail as to the types of activities (what he actually did) that were performed. If additional space is required, please use additional sheets and attach to the nomination form.
- LOCATION:** During the Detachment Convention, one nominee will be selected and receive the Son of the Year Award and lapel pin, which can be worn for all occasions during American Legion programs and events.
- CERTIFICATION:** The report can be submitted by any Sons of The American Legion member within the Detachment of Virginia. The nominee must be a member of the Sons of The American Legion, Detachment of Virginia, and be in good standing.
- DEADLINE:** **June 1st of each year**
